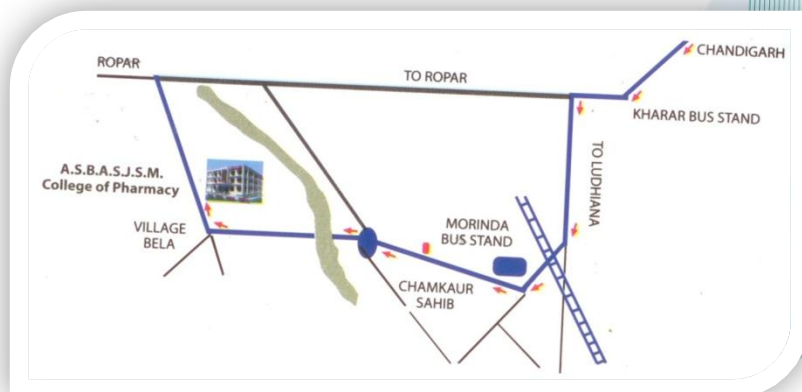

ABOUT CEP & OBJECTIVES:
