### **SELECTION OF STUDENTS AT IMTECH, CHANDIGARH**

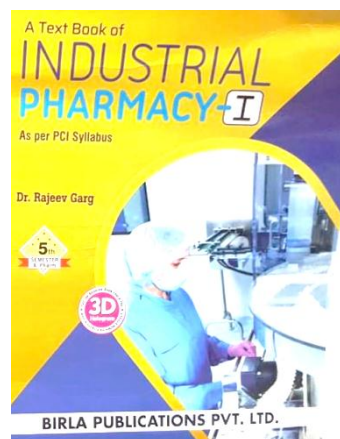
