## International Earth Day Observed

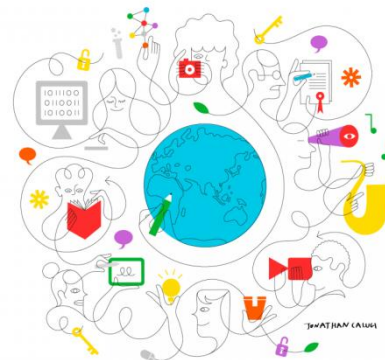
